## **Kentucky Society for Human Resource Management Announces Fifth Annual Best Places to Work in Kentucky Award Winners**

**FRANKFORT, Ky. (Jan. 23, 2009)** – The Kentucky Society for Human Resource Management (KYSHRM) State Council, in conjunction with the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce, announces the winners (see attached list) in the Fifth Annual **Best Places to Work in Kentucky** competition. The program is a multi-year initiative designed to motivate companies in the Commonwealth to focus, measure and move their workplace environments toward excellence.

Winners from across the state have been selected in two categories: small/medium-sized (companies of 25 to 249 employees) and large-sized (companies of 250 employees or greater). The selection process, managed by Best Companies Group, is based on an assessment of the company's employee policies and procedures and the results of an internal employee survey. The survey feedback that all participating companies receive will enable them to develop the plans and implement the steps necessary to create a great workplace and continue to improve the performance of their business. The actual rankings will be announced at an awards dinner Tuesday, April 21, 2009, at the Lexington Convention Center in downtown Lexington.

The **Best Places to Work in Kentucky** initiative is based on the famous FORTUNE magazine "100 Best Companies to Work for in America" list. In this issue, thousands of companies are assessed annually to compete for this honor. In addition to the positive effect the award has on their employee relations and recruitment, the driving force for companies to participate in this program is the remarkable effect that workplace improvements can have on their bottom line.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Kentucky has more than 14,000 privately-owned establishments with 20 or more employees. The goal of **Best Places to Work in Kentucky** is to raise the bar among the state's employers and create excellence and employee satisfaction in the workplace that will attract talented people for years to come. This initiative is integral for Kentucky to compete in both national and global arenas.

The Kentucky SHRM organization consists of 14 local chapters throughout the state, with a membership of over 3,000 human resources and business professionals across all industries.
