



## How to Vote in the 2026 General Election

General election day is November 3, 2026, and it is important to learn about the voting options available to you. Take a look at the opportunities to vote absentee, early in person, and on general election day.

### Can't Vote on Election Day? Request an Absentee Ballot by Mail.

**Request a mail-in absentee ballot by October 20, 11:59 p.m. local time.** [Click here](#) to request an absentee ballot. Voters are encouraged to request an absentee ballot before the deadline.

**All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by 6:00 p.m. local time on general election day, November 3, 2026, to be counted.** Voters are highly encouraged not to wait until general election day to hand-deliver their absentee ballot. The U.S. Postal Service recommends mailing completed absentee ballots no later than October 27, 2026.

### Can't Vote on Election Day? You Can Still Vote in Person.

**In-person excused absentee voting will take place on October 21–23 and October 26–28, 2026.**

### Want to Vote Early? No Excuse is Needed.

Kentucky now offers early voting for everyone, with no excuse required. **Early in-person, no excuse absentee voting will take place October 29–31, 2026.**
