Why Should You Vote?

The people you elect to represent you have a direct impact on your daily life. With that, voting is a key way to ensure **you have a voice** in making our state a better place to live and work. This year, Kentuckians will have the opportunity to elect some of the state's most important offices in Frankfort in addition to electing the president and U.S. Representatives. Below are some ways you can prepare yourself for the **general elections coming on Tuesday, November 5, 2024**.

Make Sure You Are Registered

You can register to vote or check your voter registration status by visiting **govote.ky.gov/**. The **deadline to register** for the 2024 general election is Monday, October 7, by 4:00 p.m. local time. Find frequently asked questions on voter registrations **here**.

Ways You Can Vote in Kentucky

EXCUSED, IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING (October 23-25 and October 28-30)

Excused, In-Person Absentee Voting: qualified voters may make application to cast an absentee ballot during normal business hours during the six (6) business days immediately preceding the Thursday of no-excuse in-person absentee voting period. To view a list of defined, designated reasons to vote in this time period, visit elect.ky.gov.

IN-PERSON, NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING (October 31 - November 2)

In-person, no-excuse absentee voting to be conducted in the county clerk's office or other place designated by the county board of elections and approved by the State Board of Elections. Learn more about where to absentee vote here.

IN-PERSON VOTING ON ELECTION DAY (Tuesday, November 5)

Polls open from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., local time. Mail-in absentee ballots must be received by the clerk before 6:00 p.m. local time.

Where to Vote in Person
